RESOLUTION OF TOWN BOARD PROPOSING TO EXCEED LEVY LIMIT VIA TOWN MEETING

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has imposed levy limits on town, village, city, and county levies for 2023 and thereafter under Wis. Stat. § 66.0602;

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 66.0602 limits the allowable local levy for 2023 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) zero percent of the 2022 payable 2023 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law* or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction less improvements removed, which for the Town of Eaton is 1.277 % (Net new construction % from LLW Line 6);

Whereas, the town board of the <u>Town of Eaton</u>, <u>Manitowoc County</u>, believes that for the 2023 tax levy (to be collected in 2024) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above by a greater percentage than <u>1.277</u> % (Net new construction % from LLW Line 6);

Whereas, the <u>Town of Eaton</u>'s 2022 payable 2023 adjusted actual tax levy was <u>\$309,719</u> (LLW Line 4), and further whereas the state law would limit this year's increase to <u>\$3,955</u> (LLW Line 4 x Net new construction % from LLW Line 6), for a total allowable town tax levy after adjustments for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) of <u>\$312,096</u> (LLW Line 10)**;

THEREFORE, the town board of the <u>Town of Eaton</u>, <u>Manitowoc County</u> does hereby resolve and order as follows:

- 1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2023 that will exceed the amount allowed by the state levy limit.
- 2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the allowable town tax levy for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) by 16.463 % (Dollar amount of requested levy increase ÷ LLW Line 10 amount x 100), which would increase the town levy by \$ 51,379 (Dollar amount of requested levy increase), for a total tax levy (after adjustments) of \$ 363,475 (Dollar amount of requested levy increase + add LLW Line 10) shall be placed on the agenda for the special town meeting to be held on November 6, 2023.

RESOLUTION OF TOWN ELECTORS TO ADOPT THE TOTAL TOWN TAX LEVY AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF TOWN ELECTORS

Town of Eaton, Manitowoc County Resolution No. 2023-3

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a) authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

Whereas, a special town meeting of the town electors has been called and properly noticed to approve the 2023 total town tax levy (to be collected in 2024), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a);

THEREFORE, the special town meeting of the <u>Town of Eaton</u>, <u>Manitowoc County</u>, Wisconsin, by a majority vote of the eligible electors duly assembled and voting on this 6th day of November, 2023, hereby resolves and orders as follows:

The town electors of the <u>Town of Eaton</u>, <u>Manitowoc County</u>, Wisconsin adopt the total town tax levy for 2023 (to be collected in 2024) in the amount of <u>\$363,475</u>. The 2023 payable 2024 adjusted actual levy is \$309,719. And further, whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$1,578 for an allowable town tax levy of \$312,096 before adjustments and \$335,799 including debt adjustment of \$23,703 for the snow plow truck payment, for 2023 collected in 2024, and the increase of the town tax levy for 2023 to be collected in 2024 which would increase the town levy by \$27,676 for ambulance costs, for an allowable total town tax levy of \$363,475.

1. The town clerk shall post or publish this resolution as required by law under Wis. Stat. § 60.80(1)(a) within 30 days after its adoption.
